# From the Pastor



## Idolatry vs. Veneration

**M**any people wonder how the Catholic Church can forbid idolatry (Ex 32:7–14) while still allowing images, statues, and veneration of saints. The distinction is very important in Catholic theology.

### 1. What Exodus 32 Condemns

Israel made a golden calf and worshiped it as a god: “*These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt*” (Ex 32:4).

The sin was **not the statue itself**, but that they **treated the statue as God**—giving divine worship (*latria*) to something created.

This is what the Catechism calls **idolatry** (CCC 2113–2114).

### 2. Catholic Theology on Worship

The Church distinguishes **three kinds of honor**:

**Latria** → Worship and adoration due to God alone (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit).

Offering sacrifice, treating someone as the Creator. Giving this to anything else is **idolatry**.

**Dulia** → Veneration or respect given to the saints, recognizing God’s grace at work in them. It’s not worship; it’s honoring them as friends of God and models of holiness.

**Hyperdulia** → A special veneration for the Virgin Mary, because she is the Mother of God. Still infinitely below *latria*, which belongs only to God.

### 3. Sacred Images vs. Idols

**Idols (like the calf)**: False gods, or symbols that replace God.

**Sacred images (saints, crucifix, Mary)**: Reminders of the true God and His saving work. The Church explains:

**CCC 2132**: “The honor paid to sacred images is a *respectful veneration*, not the adoration due to God alone.”

Images “lead us to God incarnate,” not away from Him.

This was affirmed at the **Second Council of Nicaea (787)**: Christians may not adore images but may venerate them.

Just as seeing a photo of a loved one does not mean you “worship” the photo, venerating a saint’s statue points us beyond the image to God’s glory in that saint.

### 4. Why This Is Not Idolatry

When Catholics kneel before a crucifix or a statue of Mary, the **gesture is directed to God** (or to the saint as God’s servant), not to the wood or stone.

The golden calf was adored *as a god in itself*. Sacred images are honored as **windows pointing to God**.

St. John Damascene put it well:

“*The honor paid to an image passes to its prototype.*”  
Meaning: when we show respect to a statue of Mary or a saint, it is respect to the person it represents, and ultimately to God who sanctified them.

### 5. Practical Spiritual Difference

**Idolatry** (Ex 32): Trusting in something created for salvation (money, power, images treated as gods).

**Catholic veneration**: Honoring God through His saints and remembering His works through images.

Exodus 32 condemns **idolatry**—adoring a creature in place of God. The Catholic Church completely agrees. But the Church distinguishes this from **veneration**: honoring saints and using sacred images as reminders that lead us to God. *Latria* (worship) belongs to God alone; *dulia* (veneration) honors God’s work in His saints; and images are not gods but signposts toward the divine.
