

From the Pastor



Alpha: Bringing the Mission to the Center of Our Church’s Life and Activities—Part 3

Evangelization Alpha is a tool to introduce people to an initial proclamation of the good news of Jesus Christ—the kerygma. As Pope Francis says, “Nothing is more solid, profound, secure, meaningful, and wisdom-filled than that initial proclamation” (EG, 165).

Encounter Alpha takes people on a journey often leading to a personal encounter with Jesus Christ. It enables people to ask their questions, share ideas, build friendships, and experience the love of God through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Everyone Alpha is for everyone: all backgrounds, all contexts, all ages. Alpha is particularly attracting many young people who are asking the question, “Is there more to life than this?”

Alpha is not meant to bring people all the way to a fullness of the understanding of the Catholic Faith. It is after all, Alpha, the beginning. It leads people toward an ongoing journey of conversion after Alpha. It could be involving yourself in a small group, taking an active part in one or more ministries at the Church, reaching out to the needy, etc. Alpha is only the beginning of a life-long journey!




Feast of St. Francis of Assisi Novena

Students in K–12

Register Online for Faith Formation:

- ◆ For children who do not attend St. Francis School and want to attend weekly Faith Formation classes.
- ◆ For all students (SFS or not) who are ready to prepare to receive a sacrament.
- ◆ For high school students wanting to participate in youth ministry activities.
- ◆ After registration, you will be contacted to schedule a family interview.

Weekly Faith Formation Sessions:

- ◆ Grades K–5 meet Wednesdays from 4 to 5:30 p.m.
- ◆ Grades 6–12 meet Wednesdays from 6 to 8 p.m.

Sacramental Preparation

If your child attended Faith Formation last year, **First Communion** can be received as early as 2nd grade, and **Confirmation** as early as 6th grade. If you believe that your child is ready to prepare for a sacrament, and you as parents are ready to accept responsibility for helping your child fulfill all requirements, then use the Faith Formation registration form to sign up.

For families with children receiving sacraments this year, there are four required family monthly workshops and a requirement to attend three Family Faith events.
