# From the Pastor



## Our Free Will After Death

According to Catholic teaching, our free will is something proper to us as human beings in this life, but it is not exercised in the same way after death:

**During earthly life**—We are in a state of pilgrimage (*status viatoris*), meaning we are on the way and still able to choose for or against God. Our choices have eternal consequences.

**At the moment of death**—The Church teaches that death fixes our fundamental orientation. The Catechism says: “Death puts an end to human life as the time open to either accepting or rejecting the divine grace manifested in Christ” (CCC 1021).

In other words, once we die, our will is fixed in the choice we made in life—whether for God (heaven, possibly through purification in purgatory) or against God (hell).

**After death**—We do not exercise free will in the sense of making new fundamental choices about salvation. The particular judgment (CCC 1022) occurs immediately after death, and our eternal destiny is determined.

- In heaven, the blessed are perfectly united to God and cannot choose sin anymore.
- In hell, the damned are permanently separated from God by their own definitive choice.
- In purgatory, the souls are already saved and being purified, not deciding afresh.

**We exercise free will fully in this life; after death, the choice is fixed and unchangeable.**

Some key biblical passages that the Catholic Church uses to teach that our choice for or against God must be made **in this life**, and that it becomes fixed at death:

**1. Hebrews 9:27**—“It is appointed that human beings die once, and after this the judgment.” This verse underlines that after death comes judgment, not further opportunities to choose.

**2. 2 Corinthians 5:10**—“For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive recompense, according to what he did in the body, whether good or evil.”

St. Paul stresses that our actions while in the body determine our eternal outcome.

**3. Luke 16:19–31 (Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus)**—After death, the rich man finds himself in torment, while Lazarus is comforted. Abraham tells him: “Between us and you a great chasm is established, to prevent anyone from crossing who might wish to go from our side to yours or from your side to ours.”

This shows the permanence of the soul’s state after death.

**4. Matthew 25:31–46 (The Final Judgment)**—Jesus describes the separation of the sheep and goats at the final judgment.

The destinies—“eternal life” or “eternal punishment”—are presented as final, not open to later change.

**5. John 9:4**—“We must work the works of him who sent me while it is day; night is coming when no one can work.”

The “day” = our earthly life; the “night” = death, when our time of decision-making ends.

**The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 1021–1022) synthesizes this:**

- **1021:** Death ends the time of decision.
- **1022:** Immediately after death comes the particular judgment.

**Scripture and Tradition agree—our free will shapes our eternal destiny here and now, but after death, the choice is fixed.**

**I pray for all of us to continue saying “yes” to our Lord daily.**
