Catholic Education—Part 2

This year we have significant additional staff support for the Middle School with four full-time teachers and seven part-time staff, providing teaching and a variety of electives. Going into this academic year, we have three Pre-K classes, and we have three Grades with 20 or more students—which has been our goal for many years. We have a total of 33 full-time and part-time paid staff for the School. That is about one staff person for every five students.

Our Catholic School is also subsidized by those who built these great buildings that most of us have inherited and didn't pay a penny to build. They were built mostly by "blue-collar" working people who saved every penny they could so that their parish could have a Catholic School. They may have their problems but, for the most part, the people using them today didn't pay a penny to build them.

As the Catholic community in town, you have a moral responsibility to send your kids to our Catholic School, or to support the financial aid fund, and support the Church and the School in other ways. Promoting a Catholic Education should become completely central and not as a side-line effort.

Parents are the primary educators of the faith—not the principal—not the parish priest. Where does this come from? It's built into the Rite of Baptism. There are three questions that are asked when parents bring their children for Baptism. The first question is: "What name have you given your child?" Although parents of newborns are often sleep-deprived, they generally can answer this first question with ease.

The second question from the Rite of Baptism is: "What do you ask of the Church for your child?" Again, parents who have generally gone through some kind of Baptism preparation course give the answer to this second question: "Baptism."

It's the third question that's the "kicker" for the parents: "You have asked your child to be baptized. In doing so, you are accepting responsibility for raising her/him in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring them up according to the laws of Christ

and His Church. Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?"

When parents answer "yes" to this question—trust me—not all of them really "understand" what they are "undertaking." It's a Marian "yes." It's a "yes" out of faith. It is a great responsibility, and providing to your children a Catholic Education where available is carrying out that responsibility.

Tuition brings in only 59% of what it takes to educate a child here at St. Francis. So, we rely heavily on fundraisers, individual donations, and the support of the Church to raise the remaining 41%.

Thanks to all who worked hard and made sacrifices so that we were able to end in the "black" for the last three years. I would like to engage in sound business practices to move the school from isolated and unconnected instances of fundraising to a sustained vision for development.

We are a school *and* a parish. It is like the two hands or legs we have. Both need to be strong to function well. Ever since we got rid of the Church debt, we have been providing greater financial support to the school. However, we need to further increase enrollment. That is the key to sustainability.

I cannot do this myself. I need the parents to send their children to our school. It is possible with some sacrifices. When each parent makes this sacrifice for their children, we will become successful as a community with God's blessings.

We have set up a Scholarship Fund to assist you, which is something that everyone can help with. Thanks to all those who have supported this fund, we had 28 students last year who were able to attend St. Francis School because of this assistance.

The Annual Giving Appeal—which is an important part of the school's annual budget—starts at the beginning of each school year. You will be hearing about it at all the Masses this weekend as another academic year starts this week.

Thanks for your support of the AGA and of a Catholic Education.

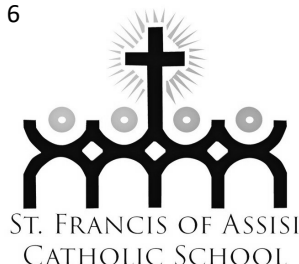

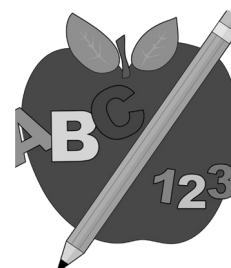
St. Francis Annual Golf Tournament
