From the Pastor



Slavery in Christianity in the Light of the Letter to Philemon

The Letter of St. Paul to Philemon is one of the shortest texts in the New Testament, yet profoundly revealing about how the Gospel transforms human relationships.

Paul writes from prison to Philemon, a Christian from Colossae, about Onesimus, his runaway slave who had converted to Christianity.

In the Greco-Roman world, slavery was an accepted institution—an essential part of the economy and social life. Slaves were considered property, without full rights. However, Paul does not address the issue from a legal or political perspective, but from the novelty of the Gospel.

Paul does not demand that Philemon free Onesimus as a mere act of social justice. What he asks is more radical: he urges him to receive him “no longer as a slave, but as a beloved brother.”

With these words, Paul is planting a revolutionary seed. He recognizes that in Christ, social divisions collapse—that the dignity of every person does not depend on legal status—but on belonging to the Lord.

The letter shows us how Christianity did not justify slavery, but it began to undermine its foundations from within:

- **Fraternity in Christ** transcends every relationship of power (Gal 3:28).
- **Christian love** demands recognizing the other as an equal, not as an object of possession.
- **The community of faith** becomes a space where master and slave can sit together at the same Eucharistic table.

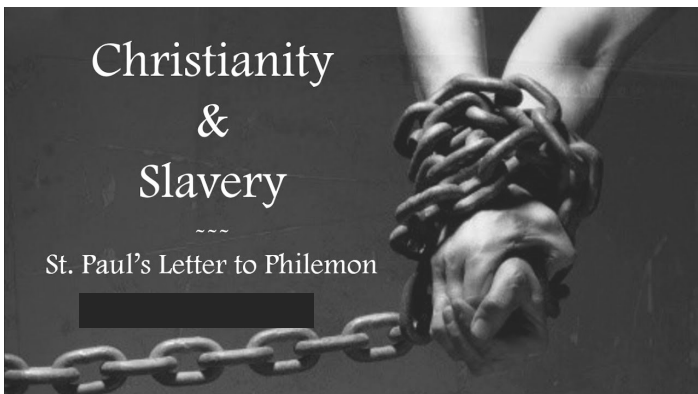
Although the legal abolition of slavery took centuries to arrive, the seed planted in this letter prepared the ground for the Christian conscience that would eventually reject slavery as contrary to faith in Christ.

Today, this letter challenges us: What forms of modern slavery still exist—exploitative labor, social exclusion, dependencies that rob us of freedom?

Paul’s message remains relevant: in Christ; every human being is a brother or sister, worthy of love, respect, and freedom.

Let us ask the Lord that our hearts may not grow accustomed to injustice, that our faith may not be only beautiful words, but concrete gestures of welcome, solidarity, and liberation.

May every encounter with a brother or sister be an occasion to recognize Christ, who came to set us free.
