

# From the Pastor



## An anxious start that ended with blessings!

I sincerely want to thank you for all your prayers and support for my safe trip to India. It was a blessed time—after a very anxious start.

The reasons for this trip were two-fold: one, to officiate at my Mom's first anniversary of her death; and, two, to officiate at the wedding of my nephew. Both of these events went well with the help of your prayers and two wonderful parishioners!

I don't know why, but it has become increasingly clear that air travel does not go well for me most of the time. I got up on the morning of my flight to a text message that said my flight from Redmond to Seattle was canceled because the crew needed rest, and that there were no more flights available for the next two days. Needless to say, I missed the rest of my flights.

I was looking forward to making the longest flight I have ever made—16-1/2 hours—from Seattle to Singapore. Alaska Airlines, which had canceled my first flight to Seattle, was the least helpful, despite spending hours with agents at the counter and over the phone. I was told I had to drive over to Portland to have a United Airlines flight agent help me with rerouting my travel via Frankfurt. Long story short, the journey took 36 hours instead of 26.

I had to get to my church directly from the New Delhi Airport. I got myself ready in 10 minutes and, when I walked up to the altar, I was only a half-hour late to preside over my Mom's Anniversary Mass. (I'm sure Mom was praying for me during my travels.) Those who had arrived for the celebration—about 200 of them—had been informed that I was running late, and they were very patient. After the Mass, we had prayers at her grave site, followed by a very nice luncheon, where I could visit with my family and friends.

I was then honored to bless the wedding of my nephew Abhi to Annies. Abhi grew up in New Delhi and is a computer engineer. Annies is a nurse. She was born in India but grew up in Canada where her family migrated when she was about 10 years old.

Most marriages in India are arranged, and my nephew's was no exception. Parents usually find the matches for their son/daughter. They enquire about the family, education, and character of the prospective boy/girl from friends and neighbors and, if found to be a proper match, would propose to their son/daughter. The boy/girl then has the opportunity to meet and talk—and let the parents know if they like the proposal.

Weddings in India can last many days. Once the boy and the girl consent to marry, the parents finalize the date, which becomes the betrothal ceremony. My nephew's betrothal ceremony took place a year ago. Customarily, the Catholic engagement party takes place at the home church of the girl, while the wedding takes place at the home church of the boy. The time gap between the engagement ceremony and the wedding ceremony could be days or weeks. Marriage bands are read at the churches of the bride and groom for at least three weekends. The engagement party of my nephew was on January 4th, and the wedding was on January 6th. On the night previous to a wedding day, there are special customary ceremonial celebrations that take place at the homes of the bride and groom. All of these celebrations went very well, and Abhi and Annies said "I do," thus "tying the knot" to be together for life within the celebration of the Holy Mass in the presence of more than 500 guests.

I cannot thank Jan Michelsen enough for driving me to the airport that day in Redmond, and for staying with me during that entire ordeal, making numerous phone calls to many people at 5:30 in the morning, while I was on my phone with Alaska Airlines.

And my never-ending thanks to Bruce Kjesbo for instantly dropping everything that morning to drive me to the Portland Airport—**and he got me there in only three hours!**






