# **F**rom the **P**astor



## “Martha, Martha”—The Anxiety that Comes From Not Trusting in God

**I**n last week’s Gospel, according to Luke (10:38–42), we find Jesus visiting the home of two sisters, Martha and Mary. While Mary sits at the feet of the Master to listen to His Word, Martha becomes overwhelmed with the tasks of hospitality. Frustrated, Martha turns to Jesus and complains: “Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her to help me.”

Jesus responds gently: “Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things; only one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the better part, and it will not be taken from her.”

This short but profound Gospel passage teaches us an important spiritual truth: anxiety often arises from not fully trusting in God. Martha wasn’t doing anything wrong by serving. What Jesus points out is not her work, but her inner unrest—her anxiety.

Martha is distracted, burdened, and upset because she is focusing more on what seems urgent than on what is truly essential. She is so caught up in her tasks that she fails to recognize the transformative presence of Jesus in her home. This reveals a lack of trust: she believes everything depends on her, and that if she doesn’t do it all, things will fall apart.



Mary, on the other hand, represents the attitude of trusting surrender. She sits at the Lord’s feet and listens—not because she despises work, but because she knows that nothing has meaning if it doesn’t flow from a relationship with God. Mary understands that true peace doesn’t come from doing, but from being—being a disciple—being a daughter of God—being in His presence.

Catholic teaching reminds us that trusting in God is not passive resignation but active faith and openness. When we do not trust in God, we become slaves to our worries. We stress about the future, we are anxious about what we cannot control, and we carry the burden of thinking that everything depends on us. But when we place our lives in God’s hands, we begin to live with peace, knowing we are not alone and that He provides.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church expresses it this way: “Filial trust is tested . . . when we think we are not heard. The Gospel invites us to ask ourselves: ‘How much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?’” (Lk 11:13) / (CCC 2734). In other words, God may not always respond as we expect, but He never ceases to be present or to care for us.

In a world where anxiety is increasingly common, this passage reminds us to pause and return to what is essential: God is with us and trusting Him is the deepest remedy for the restless soul.

Like Mary, we are called to choose the better part: to open our hearts, sit before the Lord, and let His Word restore our peace.

As part of a continent-wide pilgrimage honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe and promoting the sanctity of human life, one of the eight Silver Roses made its way through St. Francis on July 14th.
