



## From the Pastor



### The Chaste Heart of St. Joseph

**T**he virtue St. Joseph is probably most well-known for is his chastity. He is frequently referred to as the Most Chaste Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This virtue shows St. Joseph's strength of character. St. Joseph's strength of character extends to all aspects of his life and his person—including his chaste heart, mind and body. Unlike St. Joseph, we tend to struggle, and oftentimes fail, with matters of the heart, mind and body.

“Chastity is a moral virtue. It is also a gift from God, a grace, a fruit of spiritual effort. The Holy Spirit enables one whom the water of Baptism has regenerated to imitate the purity of Christ” (CCC 2345). It is the human and divine virtue that enables human love to burn more brightly. It purifies the lover of anything other than to desire what God wants for his beloved. It is a hallmark of presence of the Holy Spirit and a dominant characteristic of St. Joseph's love for Our Lady. It enabled him to fulfill his responsibility of providing and protecting her in every circumstance in a manner entirely above any suspicion or reproach.

Far from being a rare exception of pure love that is difficult to imitate, his chaste love for Our Lady in a way becomes the prototype for all love because it is the model for the self-surrendering, redeeming love with which Jesus laid down his life for the Church.

In 1998, a Brazilian university student named Edson Glauber received an apparition of Jesus and Mary. Jesus and Mary stressed the importance of devotion to the Most Chaste Heart of Joseph.

These apparitions continued over the years when, in March of 1998, St. Joseph himself appeared to Edson. He appeared to Edson over the course of eight days during that month, speaking more about his Chaste Heart, giving warnings, making promises to those who spread this message, and establishing a way to celebrate this devotion.

To celebrate and foster devotion to St. Joseph's Heart, he gave directions to pray to him on the first Wednesday of every month in a manner similar to the first Friday and Saturday devotions. You can pray the rosary of the seven sorrows and joys of St. Joseph.

St. Joseph also recommended the simple formula of one “Our Father,” one “Hail Mary,” and one “Glory Be.” There are multiple prayers to St. Joseph that you can pray on the first Wednesdays.

During the course of the apparitions, St. Joseph stressed that the devil would continue to attack humanity's virtue of purity—an attack that has only grown stronger and more vehement since St. Joseph spoke about it in 1998. With the internet and the explosion of pornography, the attack of the devil has worldwide reach. He gets into our living rooms with just a matter of a few clicks. Yet, St. Joseph did not leave us without hope: “And it is because of this, that God asks all humanity to have devotion to my Chaste Heart. He wants to give men the grace to overcome the temptations and attacks of the devil in their day-to-day lives.”

The Sacred and Immaculate Hearts were both revealed at pivotal times during the Church's history, and it seems that the Most Chaste Heart of Joseph has followed that pattern, given all that happened in and shortly after 1998. He made two main promises to those who would devote themselves to his Heart. The first was that these devotees would be chaste, righteous and holy in God's sight, and that Joseph himself would fill them with graces and help them to grow every day in holiness. The second promise was that if his devotees do good works for the sick, dying, and needy, he would petition for them during the time of their death, and they would spend their last hours resting in the Sacred, Immaculate, and Chaste hearts.



## Guidelines for Lent 2021

Lent prepares the faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection. It is a time for reflection and spiritual renewal—a time to examine one's relationship with God and with others.

Lent is also the final period of preparation for catechumens who are seeking to be baptized at the Easter Vigil.

As Catholics, the Church calls us to a spirit of repentance—to turn away from sin, and to be faithful to the Gospel. Through the traditional practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we express conversion in relation to ourselves, to God and to others.

Below are the Church's definitions of "fasting and abstinence," as well as the obligatory minimum requirements that she requires of us.

**Abstinence:** Meat and poultry are removed from our meals—fish is acceptable.

**Fasting:** Eat one (1) full meal and two (2) smaller meals—no snacking during the day.

- ◆ All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- ◆ All Catholics 14 years and older are to abstain from meat and poultry on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.
